Residents report orange to black tap water, sometimes with thick, filmy "goop" or black flecks. Some residents drive 20 mins. away or longer to retrieve water from roadside springs like the one on US Route 52 in Maybeury. Water testing reports lead, E. coli, and coliform bacteria in these springs. Senior residents rely on their neighbors to retrieve this water for them.

Doing laundry can ruin clothes, and showering in Avondale can lead to burns on skin. Plumbing becomes corroded and stains on water fixtures cannot be scrubbed away. Cooking, drinking, cleaning, and preparing for the day is a hardship.

Many residents routinely spend over \$100 per month on bottled water. Filters can cost hundreds to thousands. Some Gary residents are paying up to \$180 a month for water they cannot use.

McDowell County is one of the poorest counties in America.
